

OUR HISTORY

1941

GLOUCESTERSHIRE ASSOCIATION OF YOUTH CLUBS

Formed to help young people through their leisure time activities to develop their physical, mental and spiritual capacities so as to become purposeful individuals and useful members of society.

1946

GLOUCESTERSHIRE ASSOCIATION OF BOYS CLUBS

To promote the mental, physical and spiritual well-being of boys and especially boys in poor circumstances in the county, on the lines recommended by the National Association of Boys Clubs.

1955

19 October 1955 GABC constitution agreed.

1962

2 July 1962 GABC registered with The Charity Commission, remained unincorporated.

1964

21 October 1964 GAYC registered with the Charity Commission.

1981

TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY

10 March 1981 it was minuted that responsibility for GAYC be passed to GYA.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE YOUTH ASSOCIATION

24 February 1981 Incorporated as a private limited company.

27 March 1981 registered with the charity commission.

2014 For young people to have the confidence motivation and skills to improve their lives. We work to achieve this by creating opportunities that educate, inform and inspire.

National Association of Boys Clubs approves YG constitution. First Annual Review produced.

1998

MERGER COMPLETE
