# MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Infobuzz supports **FAMILIES & YOUNG PEOPLE** to address their mental and emotional needs through a range of specialist counselling and therapeutic services.

## **Transition Project**

Now in its third year the project provides counselling and practical support to 16-19 year olds who are experiencing issues around mental and emotional wellbeing. The project supports young people to transition out of mental health services, into other support.



## Training For Volunteers & Professionals

The Infobuzz staff team includes professionals from a wide range of backgrounds and with our partner charity, Young Gloucestershire, we provide a comprehensive calendar of training events. Workshops include; child sexual exploitation, knife crime and how to use Gloucestershire's substance misuse screening tool.

Last year Infobuzz delivered 21 training courses to **349** volunteers and professionals. Training can be commissioned to be delivered at your organisation.

## **COMMISION OUR SERVICES**

## Work in Schools, Alternative Provisions and Colleges

Our bespoke, commissioned sessions address some of the most challenging issues faced by children and adolescents including; drug and alcohol awareness, sex and relationships and online safety.

In 2017/18 Infobuzz supported 2134 young people in 29 colleges and secondary schools. We introduced a new programme of support for year six students as they prepare for secondary school. We worked with 533 young people in **14** primary schools.









# CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES

Infobuzz provides innovative intervention work for **OFFENDERS** & **THEIR FAMILIES** to break the cycle of crime.

## **Great Expectations**

Infobuzz continues to work closely with the police, prison service and ex-offenders to offer workshops, mentoring and life changing experiences for individuals and groups at risk of offending.



#### Prison Work

Our therapeutic and enrichment sessions for prisoners are designed to offer personal development whilst providing the opportunity to deal with difficult emotions. We have been successfully delivering in Eastwood Park Prison for over 15 years, funded by Avon & Wiltshire NHS and National Health England.

### **Hidden Victims of Crime Project**

Providing families with practical support to cope with the impact of a family member going to prison. The project provides advice and guidance, counselling, mediation and advocacy.

Last year we supported **88** families and **274** individuals. We are pleased to announce the project has secured three years of funding from The Big Lottery.
